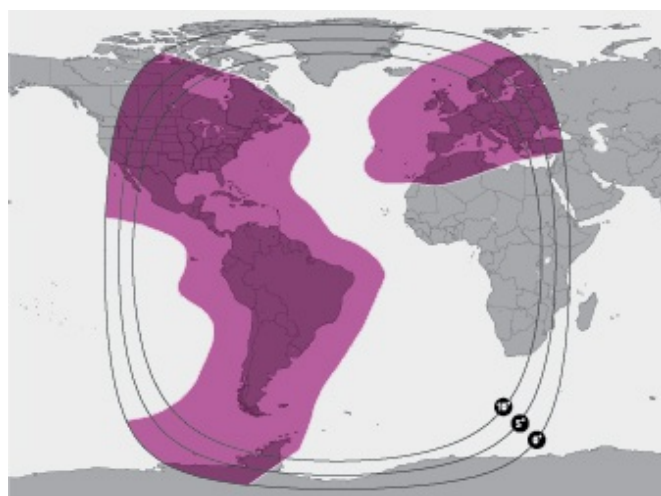

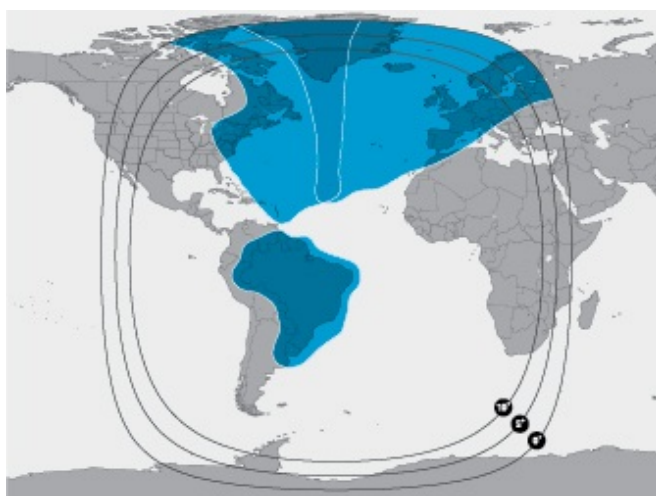

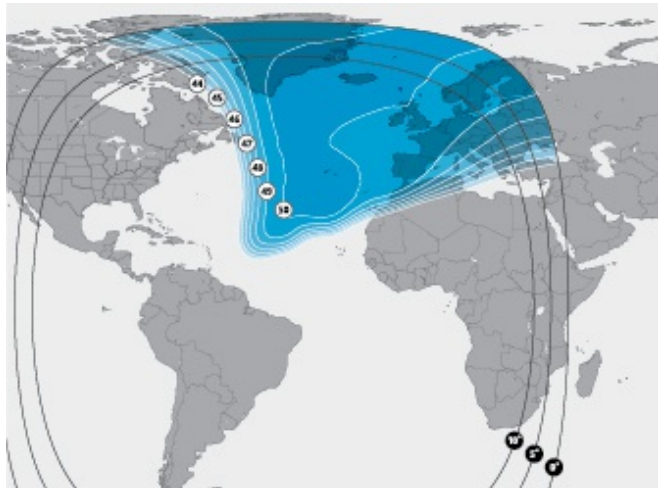

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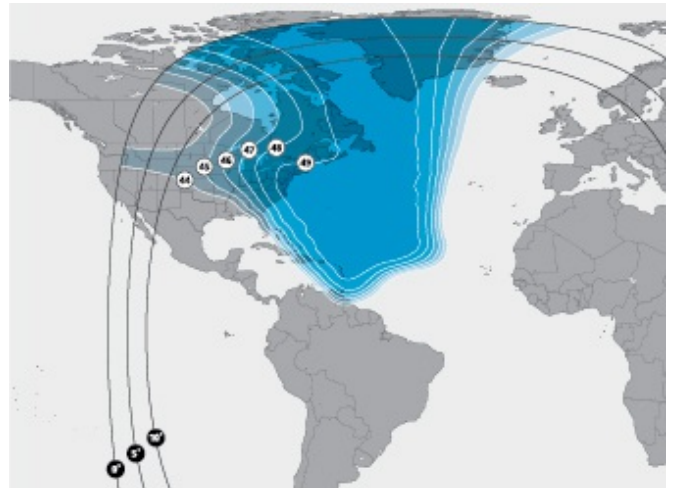

East Atlantic Ku-band beam



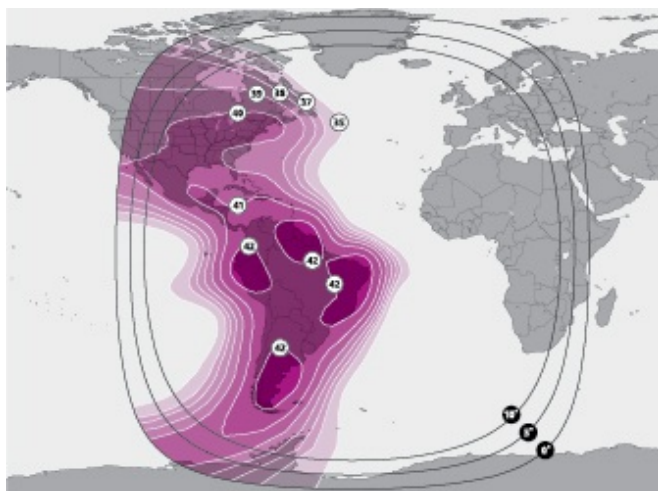

West Atlantic Ku-band beam



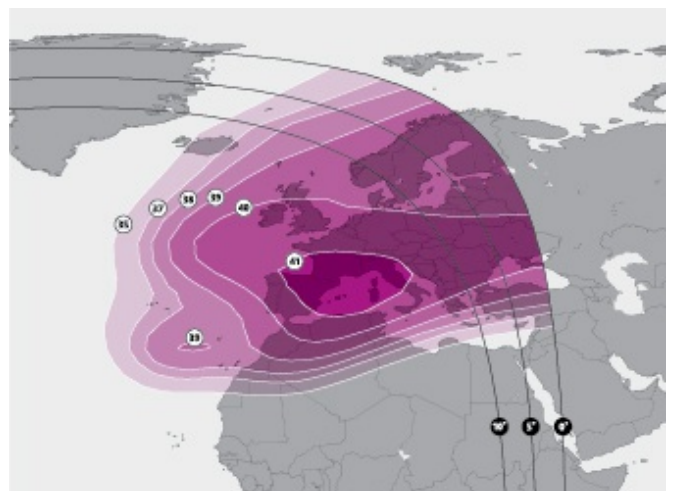
