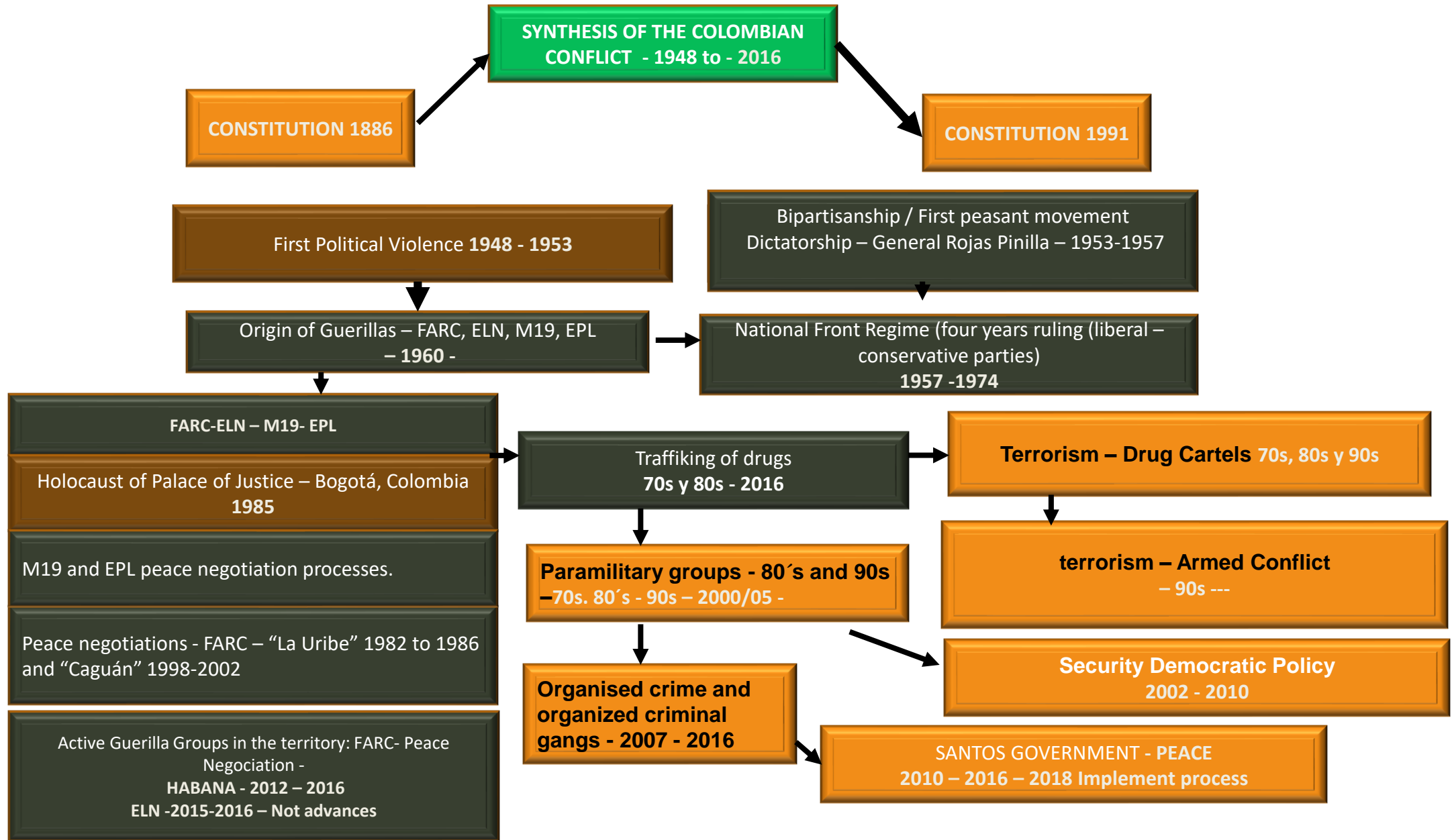

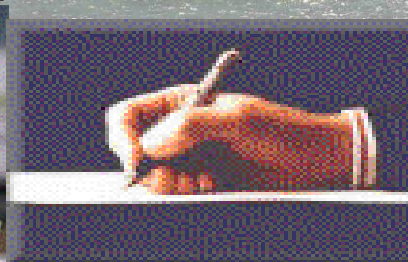
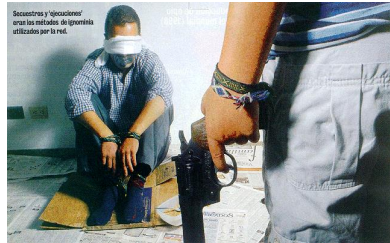

Systematic and Generalized policies – Big Scale Crime Policy.

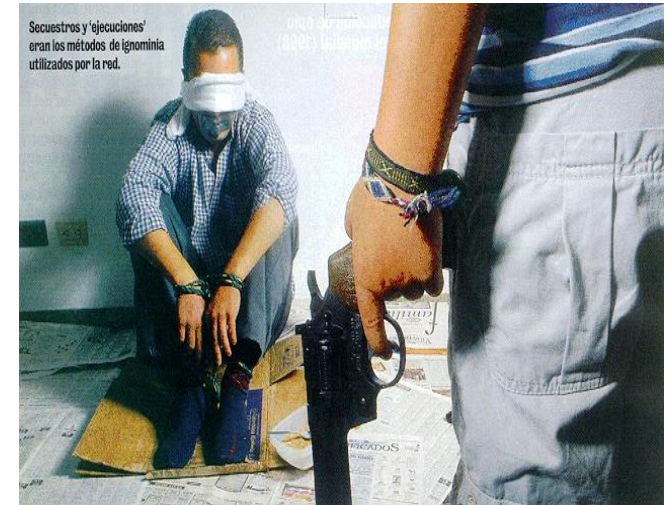

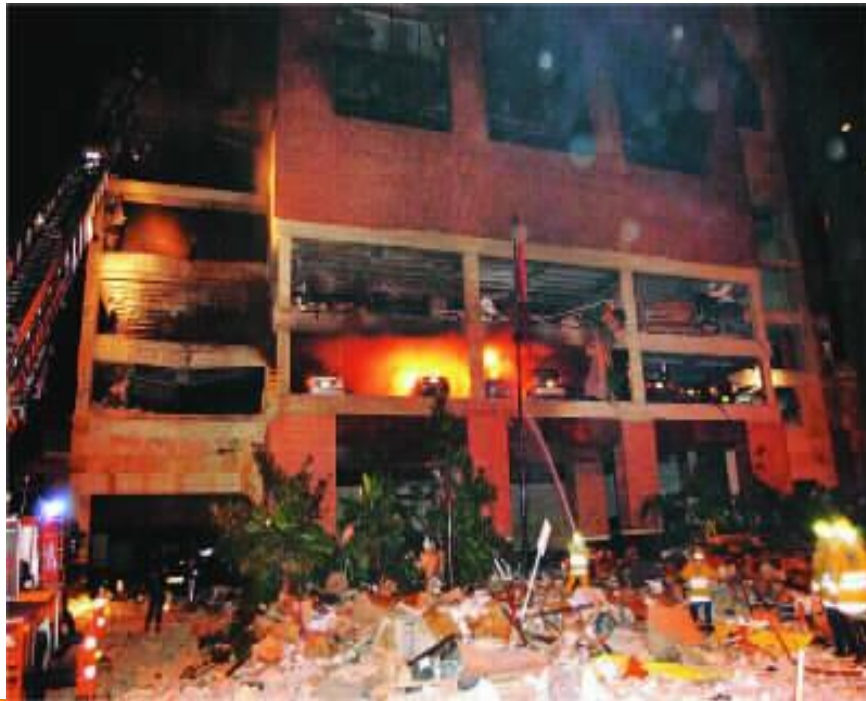
