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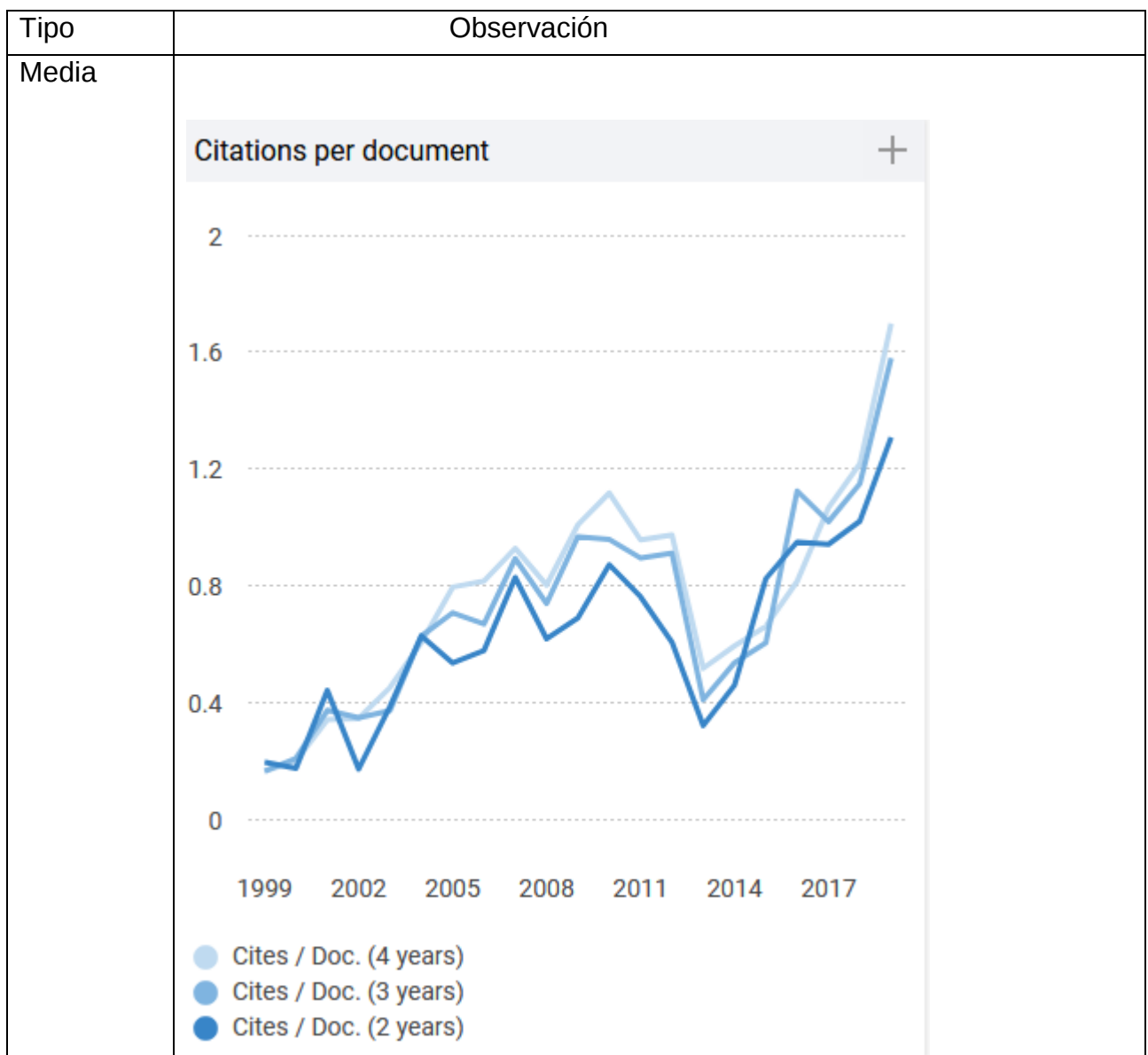

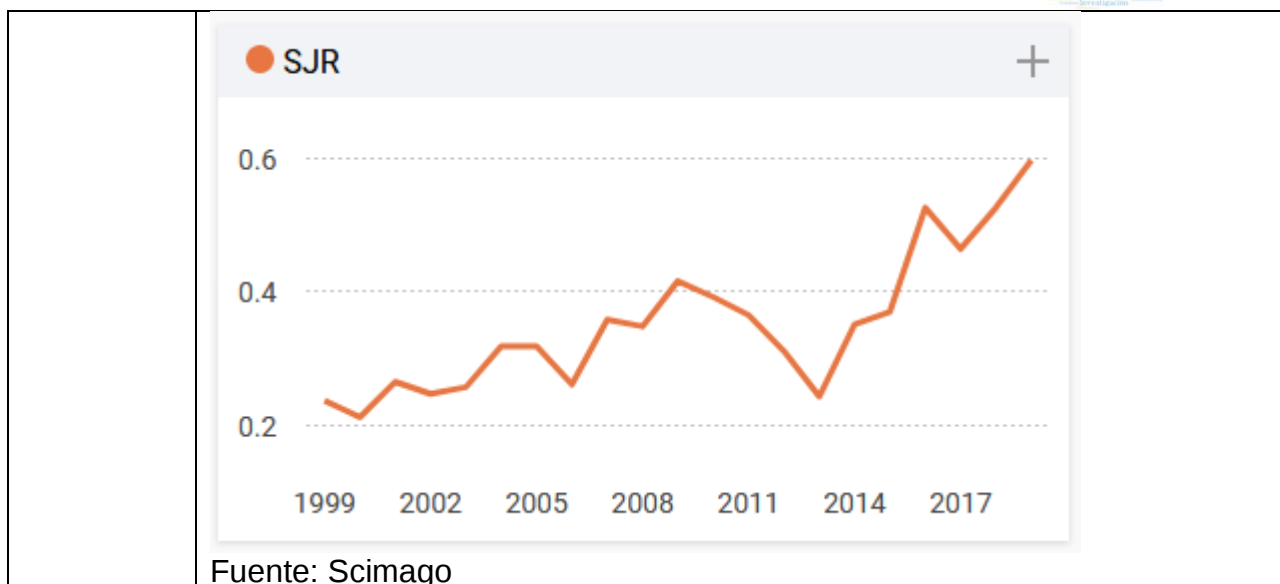

- Recientemente se actualizó el índice de WOS y Scopus por lo que también se recomienda revisar esta información para tener otras opciones de publicación en las mismas categorías de esta revista.
